

The Cox family

Descendants from John Cox (b. 11 Jan 1765 at Hanslope)

Date and revision status of the chart :

- 2013 - September 29th - first draft, by Andrew Cox
- 2015 - April 29th - this update

Scope of the chart :

- This chart is limited to just two generations.
- Two objectives are to identify all the crimes and convictions which resulted in transportation of members of the family; and all the sea voyages between England, New South Wales, Norfolk Island and Van Diemen's Land (now Tasmania).
- Subsequent generations are shown in separate charts.

Significant unresolved matter :

- What became of John and Ann's eldest child : John ? No record has been confirmed after a list on NI in Mar 1805 which records him as having "departed for Port Jackson"

Primary sources :

- The majority of the data on this chart have been taken from contemporary sources which are cited in a separate chronology

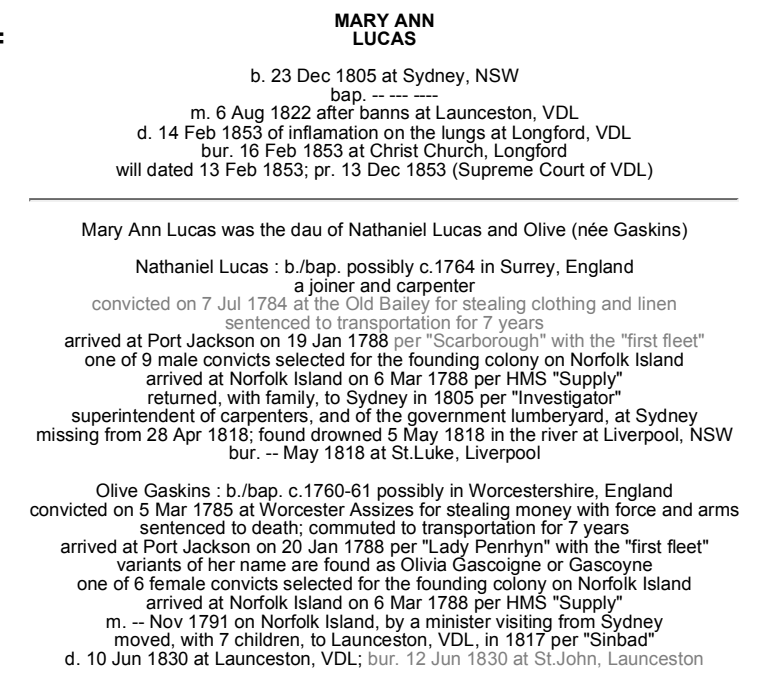
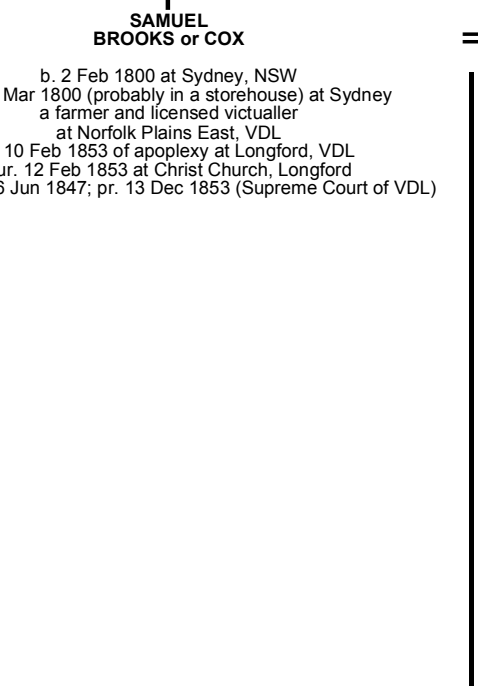
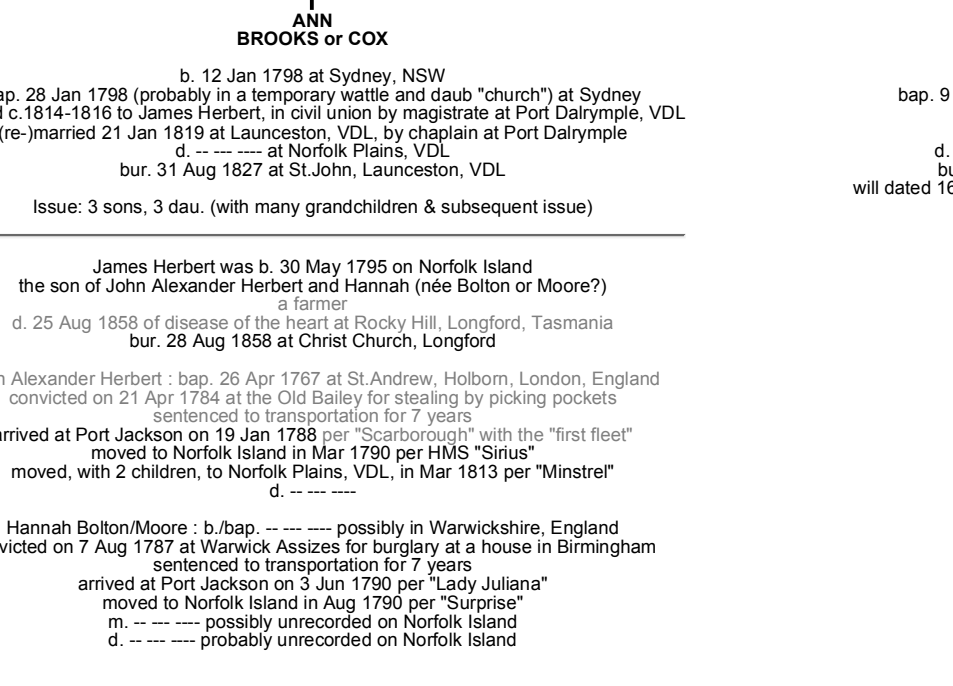
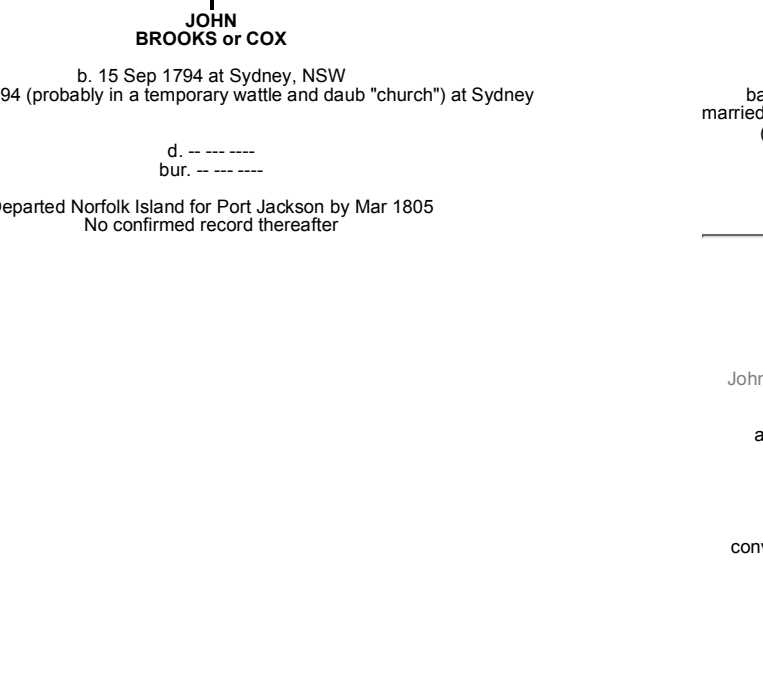
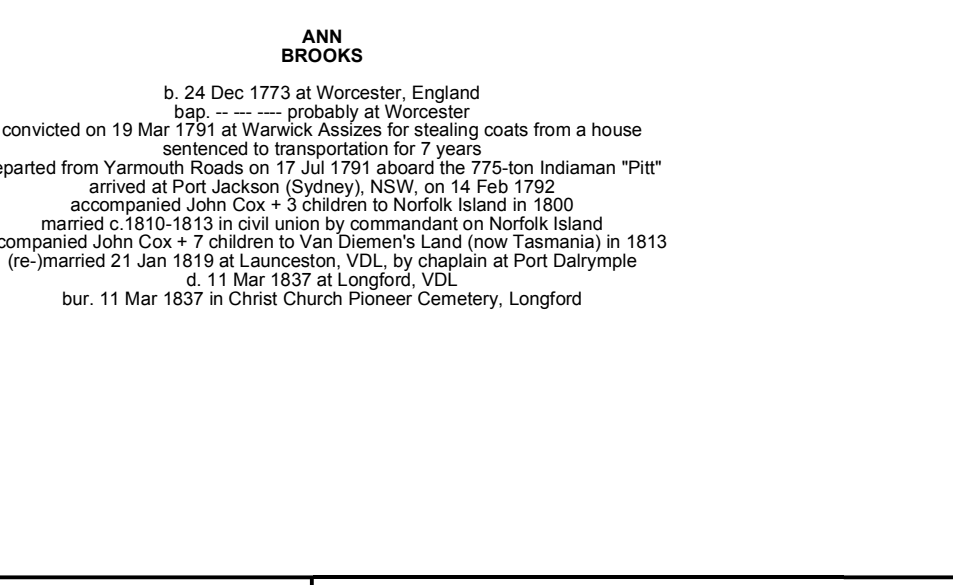
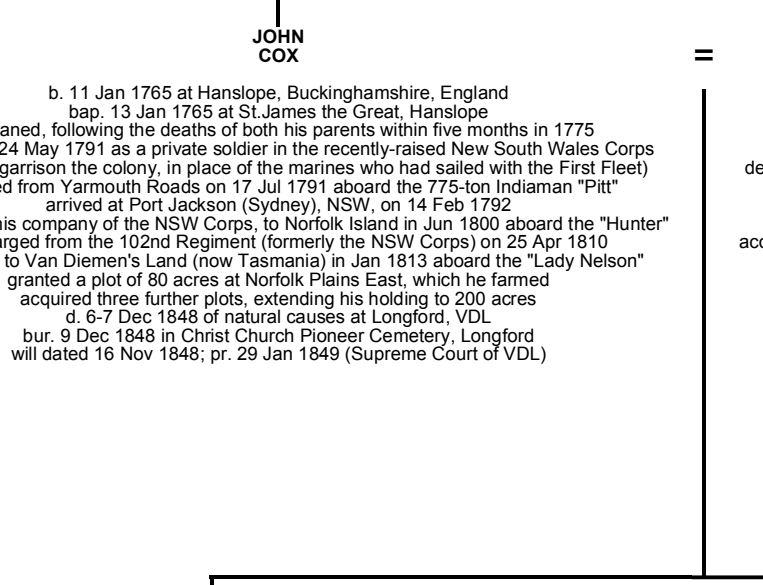
Secondary sources :

 - work is in progress to view contemporary sources to validate all details shown on this chart.

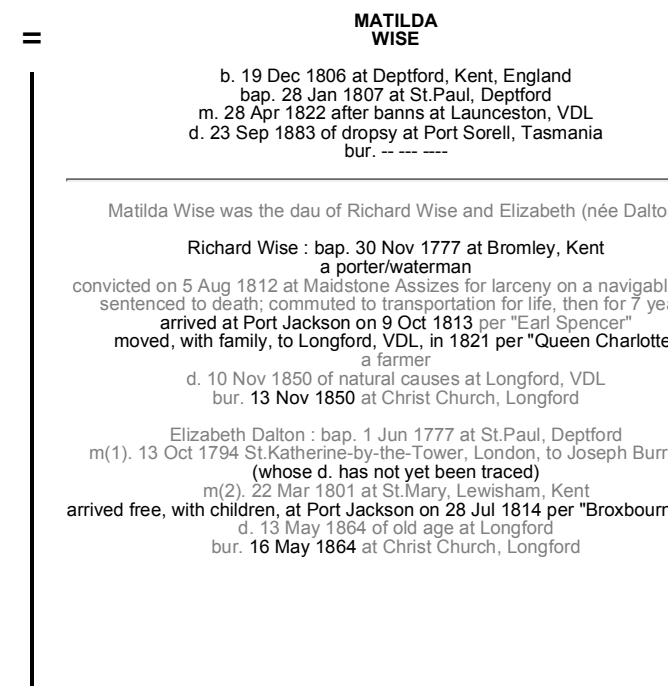
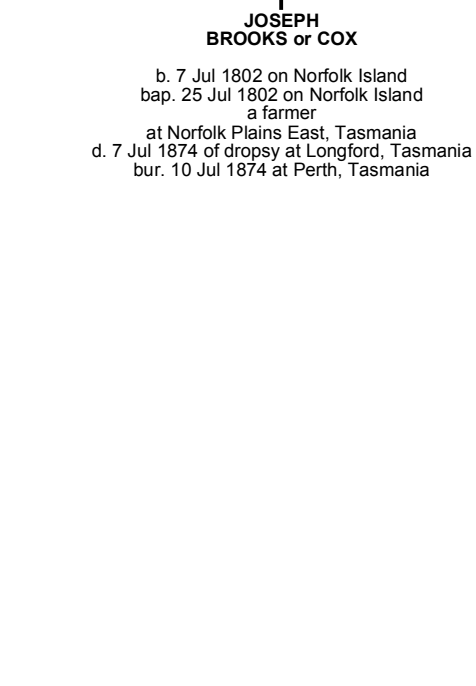
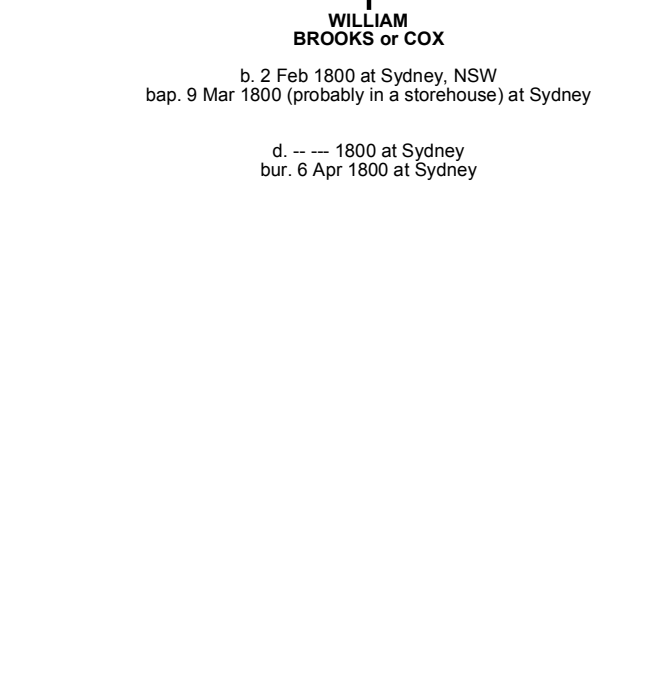
